

## TRANSPORTATION

### PRESIDIGO SHUTTLE

The free **PresidiGo Shuttle** is a great way to get to and around the park. It has two routes. **PresidiGo Downtown** provides service to and from key transit connections in San Francisco. **Presidio Hills** connects to 25 destinations within the park.

**Go DOWNTOWN Route** Transit Center, the Letterman Digital Arts Center, Van Ness Avenue and Union Street, Embarcadero BART, and the Salesforce Transit Center.

**Go PRESIDIO HILLS Route** Inspiration Point, Baker Beach, Rob Hill Campground, and Inn at the Presidio.

## GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE



**This beautiful icon** is San Francisco's most famous destination. Start your adventure at the **Golden Gate Bridge Welcome Center** where you can see artifacts from when the bridge was built in the 1930s and watch videos before walking or biking across the 1.7-mile bridge.

## #INSTAWORTHY SPOTS



**A photographer's delight**, the Presidio is home to 24 miles of **trails**, including the **Batteries to Bluffs trail**, a life-sized **Yoda fountain** at the Letterman Digital Arts Center, Andy Goldsworthy's **Spire** and **Wood Line** art installations, and eight **scenic overlooks** with postcard views of Alcatraz, San Francisco Bay, and the city skyline.

## FAMILY FUN



**Baker Beach** is the perfect place to bask in the sun, make a sandcastle, or watch the sunset with the family; head to **Crissy Field** to watch kite boarders; or visit the playground and enjoy a StoryWalk at **Mountain Lake**.

## A TRAIL FOR EVERYONE



**This 2.7-mile trail** in the western Presidio is easy to experience by foot, bike, wheelchair, or stroller. Along the way, enjoy four scenic overlooks, the forest, Pacific Ocean, and San Francisco Bay.

## EXPLORE THE PRESIDIO'S PAST



**Presidio Officers' Club**, first established in 1776, is the park's most historic building. It offers permanent and temporary exhibits tracing the Presidio's past and present. It's free and open to the public Saturdays only from 11am to 4pm.



**Fort Point**, located right beneath the Golden Gate Bridge, defended San Francisco Bay from after the Gold Rush through World War II. A visit here makes history come to life. For hours, visit [nps.gov/fopo](https://www.nps.gov/fopo).
